## Housing Advocate

### Wanda Clark Rebuilding Project

Ms. Clark is a senior homeowner in the City of Sacramento, Oak Park community, who was taken advantage of by an unlicensed contractor and found herself in a unlivable home. She had been in this home for over 25yrs until she wanted to add an addition to the home for her grand kids. The City of Sacramento was forced to condemn the home because of mold and other code violations. Ms. Clark was forced to make repairs after exhausting all her funds with unlicensed contractor and had no means to make the necessary repairs. Her case was given to predatory receivership company, who took advantage of her lack of knowledge of their process and found herself in deeper dept after four months in the receivership process. Her family reached out to Rashid Sidqe, Founder/CEO of LULA and he called on other organization (Sacramento Housing Alliance, Habitat for Humanity of Greater Sacramento, Greater Sacramento NAACP and Sacramento-Sierra Building & Construction Trades Council) to help. The City of Sacramento assisted in returning ownership to Ms. Clark after she agreed to demo her home. This was a very emotional process for Ms. Clark who has never missed a payment for a home she has not been able to live in for over six years.

It is time to rebuild Ms. Clark's home and make her whole again with the help of SSBCTC and Greater Sacramento NAACP. We are looking for financial partners to make this possible. There will be many ways to contribute to the meaningful project and provide a road map for humanity.
